The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations in the following areas commencing at **5:00 pm** daily.

**Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> November 2020** – Campden Park Port, Kingstown Port, Argyle International Inc & Spring

**Tuesday, 17<sup>th</sup> November 2020** – Rabacca, Langley Park, Chapmans, Caratal Village, O' Briens & Dixon

**Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> November 2020** – Colonaire, Three Rivers, Belle View & Sans Souci

**Thursday, 19<sup>th</sup> November 2020** – Diamonds, North Union & New Grounds

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to eliminate the adult mosquitoes inside the home.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Parents and guardians are advised to prevent their children from running or playing near the vehicle during fogging operations.
- Adverse weather conditions could lead to the postponement of fogging operations.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
